**Belle-Vue Kriek** 250ml 8.00

Kriek is a style of lambic beer with the aroma, taste and colour of sour cherries, and a sweetness to charm even the most hesitant of non-beer drinkers. Lambic beers undergo spontaneous fermentation with natural wild yeasts and are aged in oak barrels very similar to wine. Whilst in these barrels, macerated cherries are added to give it its distinctive colour and flavour.
