

LIMITED RELEASE BEERS



Ename Dubbel **330ml** **\$8.50** **6.5%**
Brewed by the Roman Brewery (the oldest family owned brewery in the world), this is a classic Belgian Dubbel. Subtle aromas of light malt and hints of sweetness. The aroma carries through to the flavour, with sweet fruitiness dominating the palate.

XX Bitter **330ml** **\$13.00** **6.2%**
Brewed by two friends to be the hoppiest beer in Belgium, pale pilsener malts and loads of fresh hops make this a great summer beer. Bitter and delicious

Achelse Extra **750ml** **\$28.00** **8.5%**
From the smallest accredited Trappist brewery in the world comes this rich, dark ale. Sweet sherry maltiness dominates the palate finishing with a dry lingering bitterness.

Scaldis Noel Premium **750ml** **\$31.00** **13.0%**
As the name suggests, this is the premium version of the Scaldis Noel, a slightly darker version of the Scaldis Amber. This premium version is a brilliant red amber colour with an aroma of raisins and golden syrup. Cloves, orange peel and complex malts make this bottle conditioned winter /Christmas ale perfect for sharing on a cold winters evening.

Poperings Hommelbier **250ml** **\$11.50** **7.5%**
*Originally brewed for the Popering Hop Festival in 1981, this beer features a pleasantly bitter taste from the heavy usage of local hops. Floral stone fruit aromas and a well rounded refreshing taste make this a perfect autumn beer. **Strictly limited stock!***

Grottenbier (Pierre Celis Signature) **750ml** **\$26.00** **6.5%**
*Extended maturation in vast underground caves in Limburg lends this dark ale a depth and intensity of flavour lacking from many other brands. A very big, deep, complex, after-dinner beer. **Brewed as a one-off batch; once it's gone, it is gone forever. Strictly limited stock!***

St Bernardus Tripel **330ml** **\$13.00** **8.0%**
This classic abbey style beer is one of the best examples around. Sweet fruity malt aroma and a huge off white head lead to a rich, slightly bitter body with hints of dried fruit and caramel. Perfectly balanced with lots of fresh Popering Hop flavours, this is definitely one for those cool autumn days.

St Bernardus Abt '12' **330ml** **\$14.00** **10.5%**
Brewed on the site of the old Westuleteren Brewery, this exceptional quadruple ale is one of the world's best. Ripe fruit & malt sweetness lead to an intensely rich flavour of dark caramel malt, sweet spiced fruits and toffee. Perfect to enjoy after dinner.

Keizer Karel Robijn **330ml** **\$13.50** **8.5%**
Named after Charles Quint (Carlos Primero or Charles V) who in the 1500's ruled nearly the whole of western European continents – Spain, Italy, and German and Austrian territories. Ruby Red beer dark ale with a smooth and fruity aroma, a smooth and full flavour and a sweet hoppy after taste.

Delirium Nocturnum **330ml** **\$12.50** **8.5%**
*Nocturnum – derived from the Latin phrase “carpe nocturnum,” meaning “seize the night”
 The darker stronger version of Delirium Tremens was first brewed in 1989 with three different yeast varieties and five malt varieties to offer a richer beer for the winter months.*

La Guillotine **330ml** **\$15.00** **8.5%**
To celebrate the bicentennial of the French Revolution in 1989, the topical beer "La Guillotine" was launched. A beer to cut your Thirst! All the traditions of a strong well rounded blonde are gathered behind the walls of the bottle coloured and opaque. A rich aroma of aromatic hops, a powerful taste and opening again at the palate and a conclusion in the same tone. These are elements that strengthen its character.

Grimbergen Optimo Bruno **330ml** **\$14.5** **10%**
Grimbergen is a group of Belgian abbey beers first brewed in 1128. They became famous for providing hospitality and their home-brewed beer to visitors, and handed down the recipe over the centuries. Nice clear dark amber coloured liquid. Beige head with great creamy characteristics. Caramel malty flavours, spiced with nice hoppy touches. Tasting gives creaminess and caramel sweetness, in combination with warming alcoholic sensations.

Chouffe Dobbelen IPA Tripel **750ml** **\$32.50** **9%**
The Brasserie d'Achouffe is a Belgian brewery based in Achouffe. It was founded in 1982 by two brothers-in-law, Pierre Gobron and Christian Bauweraerts, as a hobby. The beers have gnomes on their label, a play on the town name Achouffe, since Chouffe means gnome or dwarf in a Walloon dialect.

Trappist Achel - Blonde OR Brune **330ml** **\$13.5** **8.0%**
Achel brewery or Brouwerij der Sint-Benedictusabdij de Achelse Kluis is a Belgian Trappist brewery, and the smallest of the seven currently approved Trappist breweries. It is located in the Abbey of Saint Benedict in the Belgian municipality of Achel. It brews five Trappist beers: Achel Blond, Achel Bruin, Achel Blond, Achel Bruin, Achel Extra

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- Sloeber** 330ml \$13.00 7.5%
Is the Flemish name for an epicure, somebody who likes the good things in life in a somewhat naughty way. The Sloeber pale golden ale has a malty nose, rather hoppy and dry on the palate with hints of orange. Full of character, it is one of the best examples of the Belgian strong blond ales. A great companion for copious meals and other naughty activities!
- Augustijn Blonde** 330ml 11.00 7.0%
In 1978, the brewery acquired the recipe of the beer brewed by the Augustine Friars in their abbey in Ghent since 1295. The colour is blonde amber with a fluffy white head. The taste is full-bodied and mild, malted and hopped with a hint of vanilla. The finish is slightly bitter yet mild.
- Augustijn Grand Cru** 330ml \$12.50 9.0%
The colour is straw yellow with a nice white head. The taste is very full body with hints of malt and alcohol. The finish is dry and bitter
- Vedette Blonde** 330ml \$11.00 5.2%
a blond, light, well hopped premium beer and is the cult Duvel Moortgat beer today: following its birth in 1945, it quickly acquired fame and recognition within an intimate circle of insiders in the Antwerp-Brussels region
- Arabier** 330ml \$15.50 8.0%
De Dolle Brouwers The name means, literally, "the mad brewers" and this attitude is reflected in their whimsical graphics and adventurous brewing style. A particularly hoppy beer, dry-hopped with whole leaf Nugget hops grown in Poperinge.
- Oerbier** 330ml \$16.00 9.5%
Oerbier means original, from the source. This beer has been brewed in small scale (5 gallons) at home in a copper wash kettle, by two brothers who were students at the time. They took over an old brewery which was out of business and said: "If we don't bring the brewery back to life, nobody will!"
- Bush Prestige** 750ml \$65.00 13.0%
Wishing to create a truly original beer for the year 2000, Hugues Dubuisson had the idea of a beer aged the old-fashioned way in oak-barrels. In 2003, Bush decided that this beer was too good to be brewed just once. The old-fashioned ageing, in oak barrels, enables those who taste it to discover a unique set of aromas and tannins not found in beers for decades and sure to delight even the most demanding palates. Prestige release all its power in a complex set of aromas. Beside the woody flavours, one notes other aromas such as those of whiskeys and brandies.
- Brugs Tarwe Bier** 250ml \$9.50 4.8%
Brugs is a white beer from Bruges, Belgium, based on a traditional Brabant brew. The name comes from Dutch "Brugs tarwebier", which means "wheat beer of Bruges". Brugs was first brewed in Bruges, capital of West-Flanders. Every bottle of Brugs bears the "Golden Tree" (Gouden Boom), harking back to the trophy traditionally awarded to the knights that won the tournaments held in the city back in the Middle Ages. The beer is pale yellow, slightly cloudy beer with a refreshing tartness. It's made from wheat and hops and is seasoned with bitter orange and coriander. The beer is unfiltered which allows it to keep the natural cloudiness given by its yeast. Often served with a slice of lemon, the beer has very low bitterness and a dense, creamy head.
- Watous Wit Bier** 250ml \$9.50 5.0%
Pale golden, hazy. Big thick dense head. A spicy citrus coriander aroma, assertive without being overpowering. Light body, hugely fizzy. Nice and sweet, with very pleasant coriander spiciness. Finishes clean and dry and just slightly perfumey
- Gouden Carolus Ambrio** 330ml \$13.00 8.0%
*Gouden Carolus Ambrio, the third colour of the "Great to Beer a Belgian" tricolour. Ambrio is an 'amber' coloured beer.
In the past, every town in Belgium had its own beer typical of the area. Ambrio has its roots in the traditional beer of Mechelen known as "Mechelschen Bruynen" or "Mechelen Brown". The balance between the different malts, the fine hops and typical tastes of spices creates a perfect harmony between the powerful taste of brown beers and the freshness of the blond beers.*
- Gouden Carolus Cuvee Van De Keizer Blauw/Blue** 750ml \$33.50 11.0%
Every year on the 24th of February, the birthday of "Charles the fifth", the Brewery brews the Gouden Carolus "Cuvee of the Emperor" in a limited quantity and with an eye on the highest quality and tradition. This unique brewing, with only extra fine Belgian hops and with a higher alcohol level, guarantees a better evolution in the time, than the already known Gouden Carolus. This beer, as all their beers, is 100 % natural, with no preservatives, no adjuncts (modifiers) and no chemicals.
- Duivels Bier - Saison Farm house ale** 750ml \$33.50 11.0%
*Flavor profile is composed of fresh olives, apple tartness and lightly bitter hoppy finish. Thin bodied and slightly prickly from delicate although abundant carbonation.
This beer is characterized by highly unusual green olive aroma/flavor which gives it some sort of vegetable component unlike to find in any beer.*
